means I serve as a temporary Lieutenant Governor for the Circle K Empire Division (which coincides with the Kiwanis divisions of Brooklyn, Queens West, and Queens East).

Queens West Kiwanis Protocol

Protocol is good manners and etiquette observed during meetings and special courtesy, dignity and respect shown for visitors, especially Kiwanis District & International Officers. The following list is intended for your information and guidance.

The Official Visit(s) of the Lieutenant Governor to a club are important and should be used as an educational meeting. The club President should set aside at least three (3) meeting for the Lieutenant Governor as a speaker. (A) Installation of Officers (B) Official Lieutenant Governor visit (C) Board of Directors Meeting.

The club President should always show a cordial relationship with the Lieutenant Governor.

When the Lieutenant Governor visits each club, the club assumes the expense of his/her meal. Complimentary meal arrangements should be made prior to the Lieutenant Governors arrival.

Visiting Kiwanis Leaders (Governor, Lieutenant Governor, etc.) should be seated at the head table and recognized once during the meeting.

When both the District Governor and Lieutenant Governor are present at a club meeting, the club President introduces the Lieutenant Governor who, in turn, introduces the District Governor.

General introductions include interclub delegations, visiting Kiwanians, potential members, representatives of sponsored youth programs and other guests.

Each club President or Presiding officer should have a timed agenda for each meeting. All meeting should start and end on time. All speakers should be informed of club procedures and the time limit for their presentation.

Military Children to Kamp


The 2018-19 Governor's Project is to send 100 additional military kids from Fort Drum and other military bases to Kamp Kiwanis.
