# Message From Lieutenant Governor Carol Masiello



I never heard of Kiwanis when I was growing up. I became aware of Kiwanis shortly after I accepted what I thought would be a temporary job as a drug prevention counselor at a local junior high school. At the time, I was completing my Master's Degree in psychology and I had a totally different career track in mind. While working as a

prevention counselor, I realized the need to network with the community. Kids were only in school six hours a day. A large part of drug prevention involves providing kids with positive alternatives to the negative behaviors some of them gravitated to. I got involved with the Youth Committee of the local Planning Board, which afforded me the opportunity to connect with all of the youth serving groups in the area. That's when I first learned about Kiwanis. The Kiwanis Club of Sunnyside adopted my school and sponsored several drug prevention educational events in the school. As the prevention coordinator, I was the community liaison. We were very grateful for their help. In the mid –eighties, the country was in the midst of a major drug crisis (the crack epidemic) and funding for additional resources was always welcomed. Ironically, this is not unlike the opioid crisis our country is currently in.

Over the years, I realized that this was not going to be a temporary job. I completed my degree, earned additional certifications in drug counseling and crisis management and was promoted to clinical supervisor for my program. I continued to serve as community liaison and my Principal joined the Kiwanis Club of Sunnyside. He brought me to a Kiwanis meeting and I gained a lot of insight into what the Club was all about. I wanted to join but family responsibilities and work commitments left me no time to get truly involved. I promised to join as soon as I thought I could to fully participate. I try to give 100 percent to everything I do.

Fast forward to 2003... I officially joined the Kiwanis Club of Sunnyside. In my time as a member of the club, I served as a board member, vice president, five years as president and two years as secretary. About ten years ago I was encouraged to attend a Kiwanis convention. My eyes were opened up to the vast reach Kiwanis has around the world. I was the only one from my club attending, but the other clubs in the Division made me feel very welcomed. Since then I have attended most of the conferences, conventions and Division meetings. I also became a member of the Queens West Foundation Board.

When I joined Kiwanis, I never dreamed that I would be a Lieutenant Governor. I've always been someone who likes to work "behind the scenes". When I was asked to consider taking on this responsibility, I responded that I would only consider it after I retired. I retired on December 29, 2016, after working for 39 years in the same school. Here it is, less than a year later, that I find myself assuming the role of Lt. Governor.

I am extremely honored to have the Division place its trust in me. I promise to do my best to attend as many events as possible and to help out wherever I can. I will always welcome suggestions. I'm not afraid to try new things. New ideas move us forward. I'm looking forward to a wonderful year!


