Message From Lieutenant Governor Carol Masiello



As I begin my final month as Lt. Governor, I've spent some time reflecting on the past year and thinking about the work that still needs to be done. Overall, I believe Queens West has had a very successful year. Many of our clubs have grown in membership. We received an award for sending the second highest number of kids to Kamp Kiwanis this year. We missed

first place by one! We have opened one new Club with an astonishing 100 members and we have another in the works. Hopefully, that paperwork will be completed by the end of the month. I believe many of our clubs will be able to claim "distinguished" status this year. However, this will only happen if your secretaries check to make sure the needed criteria are properly documented. We still need to work on strengthening a few clubs that need additional members.

The highlight of the month of August was the New York District Convention in Syracuse. I would like to thank all of the Queens West members who attended. We had a relatively small but enthusiastic group, who participated in the workshops and celebrations. Although I was officially retired as Lt. Governor at this convention, it was made clear that my term doesn't officially end until September 30. Our next Lt. Governor, Anthony Pappas, was officially installed and will begin his term on October 1. Elected at this convention was Governor-designate Hank Baker, who will step into his new role on October 1 and Governor-elect, Joe Ruggiero, who will serve as Governor in the 2019-2020 year.

The month of September promises to be a busy one. In addition to attempting to wrap up the establishment of another new Club, as well as a new Aktion Club, there are several events scheduled. LTG-designate Anthony will be holding his Presidents/Secretaries training on September 8. The KPTC Black and White Ball will be held September 14. On September 15, the Clubs of Glendale and Ridgewood 321 will co-host a fundraiser to support the families of Samantha Aiello and Dave Fitzgerald. Samantha and Dave both recently suffered near fatal medical conditions that will require very long periods of rehabilitation. The fact that this fundraiser sold out in a matter of weeks is a testament to the feeling of "family" that the Kiwanis organization engenders. On September 23, Queens West members will gather to thank our former LTG, Rebecca Ovadia, for her year of service to the Division. Finally, on September 30, the Glendale Club will celebrate its 65th Anniversary with a gala event that will also honor their outgoing president, Kerrie Hansen.

I began my year as LTG with an incredibly busy schedule and it appears that I will end my year the same way. I am incredibly grateful to everyone who has helped me during the past year. Being Lt. Governor has been a true learning experience. I thoroughly enjoyed my visits to different clubs and participating in so many different activities. My sincere hope for Anthony is that he enjoys his year as LTG as much as I have. He knows I will support him as much as I can. Even with a few bumps in the road along the way, the overwhelming feeling of support I've experienced from my fellow Kiwanians is something I will cherish for the rest of my life.

At our final Division meeting for this Kiwanis year, I will pass the LTG banner and gong over to Anthony. This meeting will be held on September 17 at Sidetracks. I hope you can join me in wishing Anthony a successful year. This will be our last meeting at Sidetracks. Division meetings will be moving to Porto Bello Restaurant in Astoria beginning with the October Division meeting.

Once again, thanks so much for your support and encouragement throughout the year.
