#### MID-YEAR CONFERENCE

The Kiwanis Mid-Year conference, originally scheduled for February 18-21, was postponed until March 18-21.

The district has revised their plans to hold a virtual Mid-Year conference with a small in-person component. In order to meet state health regulations, it will be necessary to restrict the in-person component to a small invitation-only group of Kiwanis leaders necessary to conduct the business of our organization. We believe, however, we can still meet our goals for the conference by holding the event virtually and by extending an invitation to attend to all our members cost free. The purpose of our Mid-Year conference is twofold. First, it is to share ideas and educational opportunities with our membership. Secondly, it is to recognize the efforts and successes of Immediate Past Governor Joe Ruggiero, our 2019-20 District Board and of our clubs during the past service year.

On the positive side it is also our hope that by holding the conference virtually we can extend the Mid-Year Conference experience to a wider group of Kiwanians, many of whom may not have attended a Kiwanis conference or convention in the past. All members of the district will be invited to attend our virtual Mid-Year. The on-line agenda will include speakers and workshops as well the recognition of Governor Joe, his board as well as club achievements for the 2019-20 service year.

#### SALT LAKE CITY CONVENTION CANCELED

The Kiwanis International Board of Trustees declared that emergency conditions will exist through Sept. 30, 2021, because of the COVID-19 pandemic. This resulted in several other important decisions:

- The board determined that it would be impossible and impractical to hold a safe, accessible convention for its international membership due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. Because of this, 2021 board elections will be conducted by the Kiwanis International Council to guarantee global representation prescribed under the bylaws and current pandemic restrictions.
- The board determined that an education conference will be offered for in-person and virtual audiences. In-person participation will be limited and will follow all local health guidelines.
- •As was allowed last year, the board determined that districts may conduct 2021 convention business virtually using a house of delegates, council or other entity allowed in its bylaws.
- •Additionally, the Kiwanis International Board decided to relocate the 2022 Kiwanis International Convention from Manila, Philippines, to a to-be-determined location. The board made the decision after reviewing global health forecasts from the World Health Organization and reiterated its desire to hold a convention in Manila as soon as possible.

Further information about the schedule, registration and events to occur during the Kiwanis Education Conference will be available once details are finalized.






