In between snowstorms during the past month, there were several Kiwanis highlights. Of course, the month began with the Kamp Kiwanis 50th anniversary celebration, which I mentioned in my last newsletter. Shortly thereafter, I had the opportunity to join the Howard Beach Club at their annual dinner/dance. This was a truly beautiful event that paid tribute to their leaders, in addition to showcasing the good work that the Howard Beach Club does in their community.

Another way to help is to assist our local Key Club LTGs attend their international convention in July. The convention will be in Chicago this year and most high school students cannot handle the cost without some help.
